His recent teaching experience as an Art Instructor includes, The Art Institute of Seattle Located in Seattle, Washington, where he taught both traditional and digital art classes. Presently, Dennis works as an Instructor for The Institute of Technology located in Clovis, California. As an accomplished oil painter his brushwork is vigorous and decisive while conveying selective choices in his personal interpretation of his subjects. **Although, equally adept at painting landscapes, still life's and portraits, his work characterize as 'painterly and impressionistic.'** Dennis is also a member of the Society of Western Artist (SWA).

The Guild has undergone several changes as well we no longer have a window gallery at Sierra Vista Mall, and we lost much of the support we enjoyed from the **Veteran's Center, mostly due to changes in their administrative policies.** They are no longer allowing us to use their facility for more than 3 hours at time, which has affected the way in which we hold our meetings, and they wanted a huge amount of money to hold our shows in one of the regular rooms. This has had a positive note, however since we **moved two of our shows to Diane Breuer's Fresno Art Hub** where they were seen by many more art lovers. We still hope to hold our Old West & Rodeo show there, but if it is allowed, the show will be in **the Lobby and not in the Veteran's room.** Our board meetings were moved to the 1st Wednesday instead of the 2nd, and we are meeting at a local **Denny's.** **Since we no longer have storage at the Veteran's District, we will be dropping the Bargain Table** as a feature during the meetings. We hope to replace it with a monthly-feathered artist. Please talk to Julianne about signing up.

I hope you will all support us by participating in the Fall Show (Moved to the Art Hub) which will be held in November/December. We do still have a free site to display our work: Sunnyside Library at Clovis & Kings Canyon avenues, and I hope to see more of you bringing in art on October 4 (Tuesday morning from 11AM—Noon).

Thankfully, all our present officers have expressed willingness to continue in their duties, but we do still have several vacant offices, notable that of Vice-**President and Greeter since John Roberts hasn't** been able to make many meetings.
