CHINA 2014 OCTOBER 16- NOVEMBER 18, 2014

STUDY TRADITIONAL CHINESE BRUSH PAINTING at CHINA ART ACADEMY INTERNATIONAL COLLEGE (CAAIC). Located in HANGZHOU, it is one of the most prestigious art schools in China. This international study program was initiated in 1985 by Phyllis Case Bennett. The annual program will be led by colleague and long time participant, Joy Harvey. It is an exceptional experience for all who attend.

Classes and accommodations are provided by CAAIC. The campus is situated by scenic West Lake, and is central to the many venues available (shopping, museums, sightseeing, restaurants) by walking, public transportation, and taxis.

Excellent CAAIC instructors are provided for Calligraphy, Bird and Flower Painting, Landscape, and other subjects of traditional Chinese Brush Painting. The program is designed to benefit the novice, as well as the experienced painter. Accommodations are comfortable hotel rooms with private bath, and most meals.

ITINERARY: DAY 1 & 2: Fly American Air, LAX to SHANGHAI, BUS TO HANGZHOU HOTEL ADJACENT TO CAAIC CAMPUS

DAY 3 & 4: get over jet lag, orientation to campus and surroundings

DAY 5: start study program

DAY 30-32: bus to Hotel in Shanghai. Free time for sightseeing, shopping, museum, etc.

DAY 33: return flight to LAX, arrive same day.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE: June 20: registration and deposit of \$2500 due. Deposit is non-refundable, per person, plus a copy of your passport ASAP! If your passport expires before June 1st, 2015, renew it now!!!**

August 1: balance of fees, your up-to-date, SIGNED, passport.

You should be able to walk distances, and climb at least 3 flights of stairs without assistance. China is not a handicap friendly country. NOTE; most participants consider this to be a strenuous program.

SUBSTITUTIONS: comparable, alternative accommodations and/or scheduled itineraries for the group will be made if circumstances necessitate such changes for the smooth operation of the program.

TIPS, GRATUITIES, AND SERVICE CHARGES: Tips and gratuities generated by individuals are not included. **ADDITIONAL EXCLUSIONS:** changes, non-participation, alterations to the itinerary made by a participant will not result in a refund, for example, arriving after the start of the program and/or leaving before the end, or non-participation of any part of the program. Also excluded are meals, beverages and transportation not included in the itinerary, items of a personal nature (laundry service, phone bills, medical care, insurance of any kind, inoculations, additional art supplies/books, any non-group transfers and any item not specifically indicated as included.
