






THE GOOD NEWS




Mr. Manente was raised in Cleveland Ohio and earned his BFA at Ohio University. He remained in Cleveland for several years after graduation, teaching art in the Cleveland Public School System while working on his MA at Kent State University and exhibiting locally in group shows at the prestigious Cleveland Museum of Art and the Butler Institute in Youngstown Ohio.

He and his wife Cindy moved west to the Bay Area in 1978 and have remained in Oakland California since then to raise a family and pursue their respective careers. Cindy as a schoolteacher and administrator and Michael as a Pictorial Artist in the outdoor advertising business.

Having painted backdrop scenery in a number of productions in college Mike found he had a natural affinity for working in large formats like the ones used on the painted billboards and walls commonly seen on the streets and highways of the Bay Area. From sports stars like Reggie Jackson or super models like Christie Brinkley and even the now infamous "Marlboro" man, Mike painted them all! His work from this period, a period that is all but lost today, was twice featured in the San Francisco Chronicle in its Datebook section in June 1987 and the Sunday Focus magazine in May of 1996.

Being a highly (no pun intended) successful pictorial artist was what Mike did for a living to help support his growing family but through it all he kept up with his own art, staying with small plein air pastels and watercolors throughout the eighties. He began his own sign painting business in 1991 and by the late nineties was able to devote more and more time pursuing his art and personal vision. It was also at this time that Michael became a member of the American Society of Portrait Artists in New York City and a certified instructor of the Portrait Institute's Portrait Clubs of America also in New York.

Mr. Manente has worked in a couple of different studios over the years, both his old West Oakland studio and current one in Emeryville have been located in gritty light industrial neighborhoods. Having grown up in an old "Rust Belt" city like Cleveland Mike related naturally to the people and places he saw every day. The work presented here is a testament to his continuing fascination and love of painting what he sees.

How To Make Sales in Lockdown Mode

Brick and Mortar art shows, galleries and book stores will need to make changes to adapt to the current crisis. Going to a crowded art show reception, or visiting a Gallery during one are not healty options under Covid 19.





The same is true for holding a book signing or visiting a book store in person. However, writers, artists and galleries can still sell art and books. The key here is creating a virtual tour of of your work.

How do you do this? Well, the first thing you need are good quality photos of your art or your book covers. Make sure each photo is clear and the colors are true to the original. Use Photoshop (or any software photo editing program) to make sure the art isn't distorted.

The next item needed is to create a script to accompany the presentation. I recommend using a script because it will help you to streamline the wording, stay on topic and remember essential items like how the viewer can actually purchase what you are trying to sell.

The next step is to create your presentation. I suggest you use a good presentation program to do this. While not all presentation programs are created equal, most of them do come with tutorials, and some with a free trial.

You might not get it right the first time, but stay with it. You want to be able to post your finished presentation on your website and on social media sites like Facebook, LinkedIn, Instagram, Twitter and Instagram to name only a few, so check the format used by each site. It might not be the same for all of them.

What presentation program should you use? You can still use Microsoft's Powerpoint, although it is rapidly becoming a dinosaur in todays market.

- **IBM Lotus Symphony** is a free Office productivity suite. It also includes a presentation application for creating cool looking presentations.

There are also a few paid sites which are relatively inexpensive.

<u>www.Vimeo.com</u> for instance has a free trial and a tierd price range: Single user platform is \$7.00/month, Pro is \$20/month and Business is \$50/mo. Unfortunately, the cheapest one doesn't include video creation, but it's included in both the mid-range and Pro packages.
